**RUNWAY 1-19 CLOSED FOR SIX WEEKENDS IN JUNE & JULY 2018
BOTH RUNWAY 1-19 AND RUNWAY 3-21 CLOSED FOR ONE WEEKEND IN JUNE 2018**

Please be advised that Runway 1-19 will be closed for six weekends this summer. Additionally to accommodate work inside the runway safety area, there will be one weekend that both runways will be closed.

The runway closure will begin at 2200 (0300Z) on Friday nights and will re-open at 0500 (1000Z) on Monday mornings.

- Friday, June 22, 2018 2200 hours (0300Z) to Monday, June 25, 2018 0500 hours (1000Z)

RUNWAY 1-19 AND RUNWAY 3-21 CLOSURE

- Friday, June 29, 2018 2200 hours (0300Z) to Monday, July 2, 2018 0500 hours (1000Z)

These closures are necessary to accommodate three separate construction projects that require contractors to work on the runways, in the runway safety areas, or the arrival and departure corridors.

Please note that the construction work is weather dependent. If inclement weather is expected, these runway closures may be cancelled. Please check NOTAMs for the most current information.
